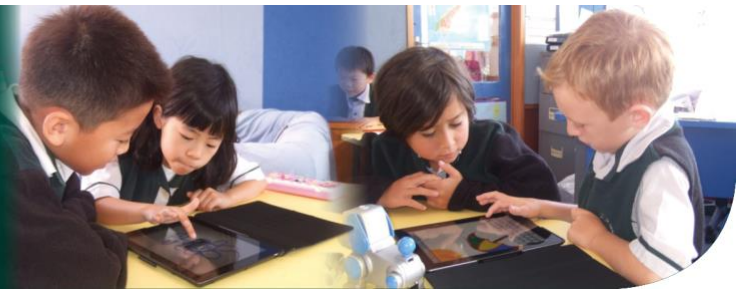

Kia ora tatou

It has been a pleasure to welcome our 487 students back to school this week. We hope you have all manged a happy summer break and are looking forward to the new school year. Thank you to teachers for all their hard mahi with preparation over the past couple of weeks. There is much planned.

Thank you to all those who attended Meet the Teacher evening on Tuesday where expectations and general information were outlined. Parent interviews where you can meet teachers one on one is scheduled for Tuesday 11 March. Just a few messages to reiterate:

Uniform

It is expected that this is worn correctly. Footwear is either black roman sandals or similar with back straps. No crocs or slides are permitted. The other option is black shoes (no white markings or soles) with silver grey regulation socks. Please ensure hats and jumpers particularly are named.

Playgrounds

These are out of bounds before and after school. Tamariki are expected to go straight home at 3pm as road patrols are waiting for them and teachers are often working or having meetings after school.

Parking

Please do not park on yellow lines or across people's driveways. I've already had a complaint from a neighbour in Pineridge Terrace this week! The owner was unable to access her property because of a Hauraki parent blocking it!

Also please do not drive into the school grounds to drop off or pick up children. Also no one is to park in the disabled park unless you have permission from us to do so.
