**ERO:** We are looking forward to welcoming the Education Review Office on **Monday 3 March**. During the three days on site they will see teaching in action, and speak with students, teachers, parents and the board. We are proud of our school and value this opportunity to share all our achievements since their last visit five years ago.

**Teacher Only Days:** The Minister of Education has allocated the equivalent of two teacher only days for 2025 to assist with the implementation of the new Maths and English curricula. These will take place on **Friday 30 May** (Kings Birthday Weekend) and **Friday 24 October** (Labour day Weekend)

**Swimming:** We are all very much enjoying the use of our fabulous new pool. The out of school lessons being run by Lauren Boyle are proving popular and we are continuing to explore ways at how to best involve the community in an ongoing way.

**Ngati Whatua:** At present we are engaging with Ngāti Whatua on the likely impact that the Marsden St housing development may have on the school. A meeting is planned in March.
